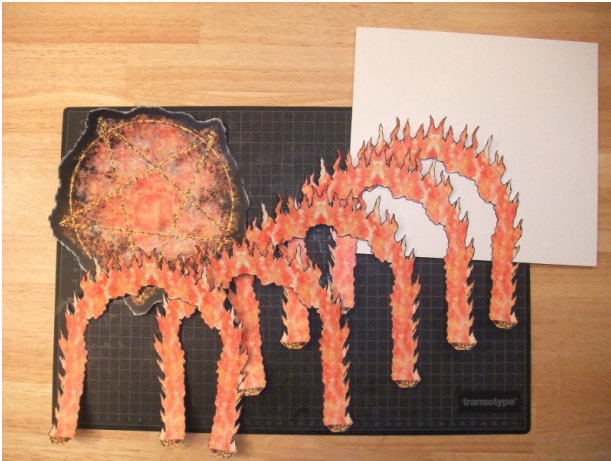
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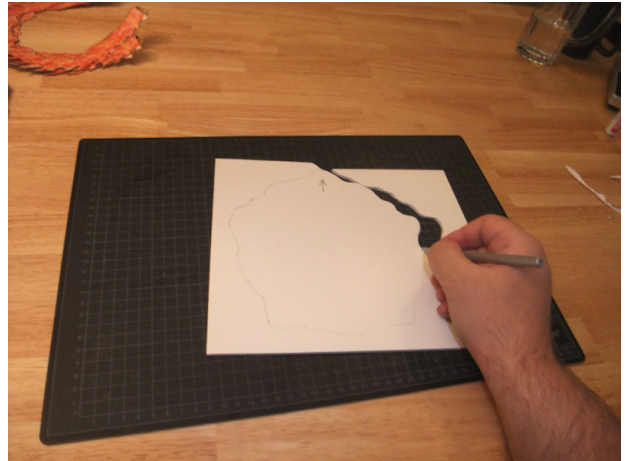
A fantasy papercraft building

Building instructions for the Portal to the Nether Realms



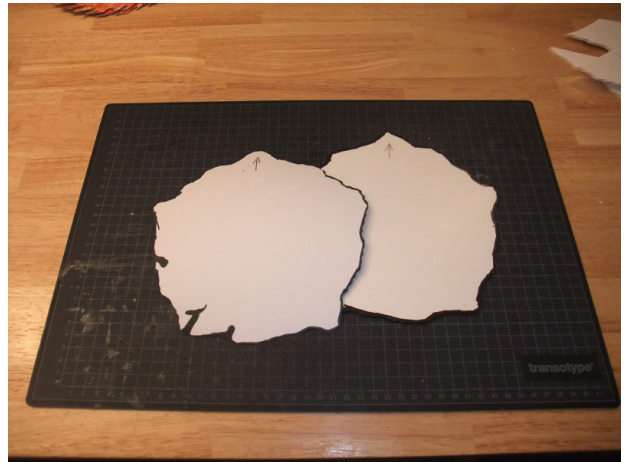
Print the ground tile once and the Arches five times, cut out all the elements; we also recommend to use a piece of foamcore large enough to mount the ground tile – 3mm or 5mm thick, whatever you prefer.



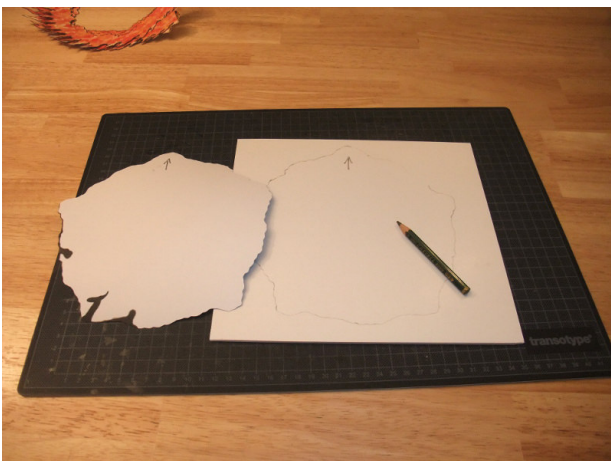
Cut the foamcore along the pencil line with a sharp hobby knife or scalpel. The narrower the blade, the more easily you can follow the line. Cutting at a slight angle that widens towards the bottom makes the cutting easier.



Place the ground tile over the foamcore and trace its outlines with a pencil.



Edge the ground tile and the foamcore with a black marker pen, then mount the ground tile onto the foamcore using your marks to ease orientation.



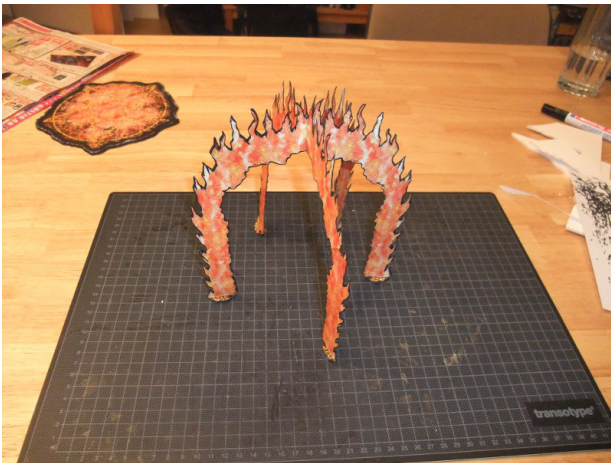
Flip the ground tile over and mark a point on it with an arrow, X or other mark; do the same on the corresponding spot on the foamcore – this will help with orientation when you mount the ground tile onto the foamcore.



Cut out the 5 arches – absolute precision is not necessary; as long as you stay within the black outline you should be fine. Edge with a black marker along the edges and the backsides of the arches.



Score and fold the arches along the dotted lines in the middle and along the tabs on the bottom. Apply glue to one half of an arch and place another half of an arch against the glued half, carefully aligning the two until they match; take care not to glue the tabs together at this point. Once aligned, carefully burnish (rub) the two halves until the glue sticks.



Work your way around the arches, aligning half after half until you close the model with the fifth arch.



Glue the arches to the ground tile one by one; align the tabs on the bottom of the arches with the tips of the pentagram.



To improve the look of the fire, carefully bend the flames into alternating directions; do this before the glue settles completely, otherwise you might crease your model.

You're done.

Congratulations – you are now the proud owner of your own private portal into the Nether Realms! The model might also serve as the representation of a gate spell, grand summoning circle, interdimensional prison or as a gazebo in an archdemon's private hellish garden – its usefulness is only limited by your imagination.
