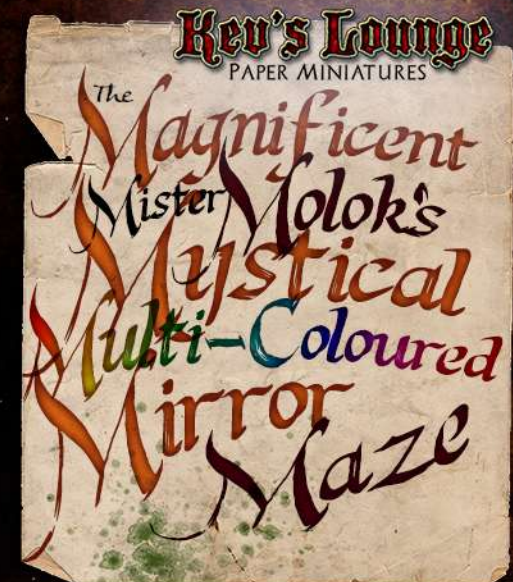

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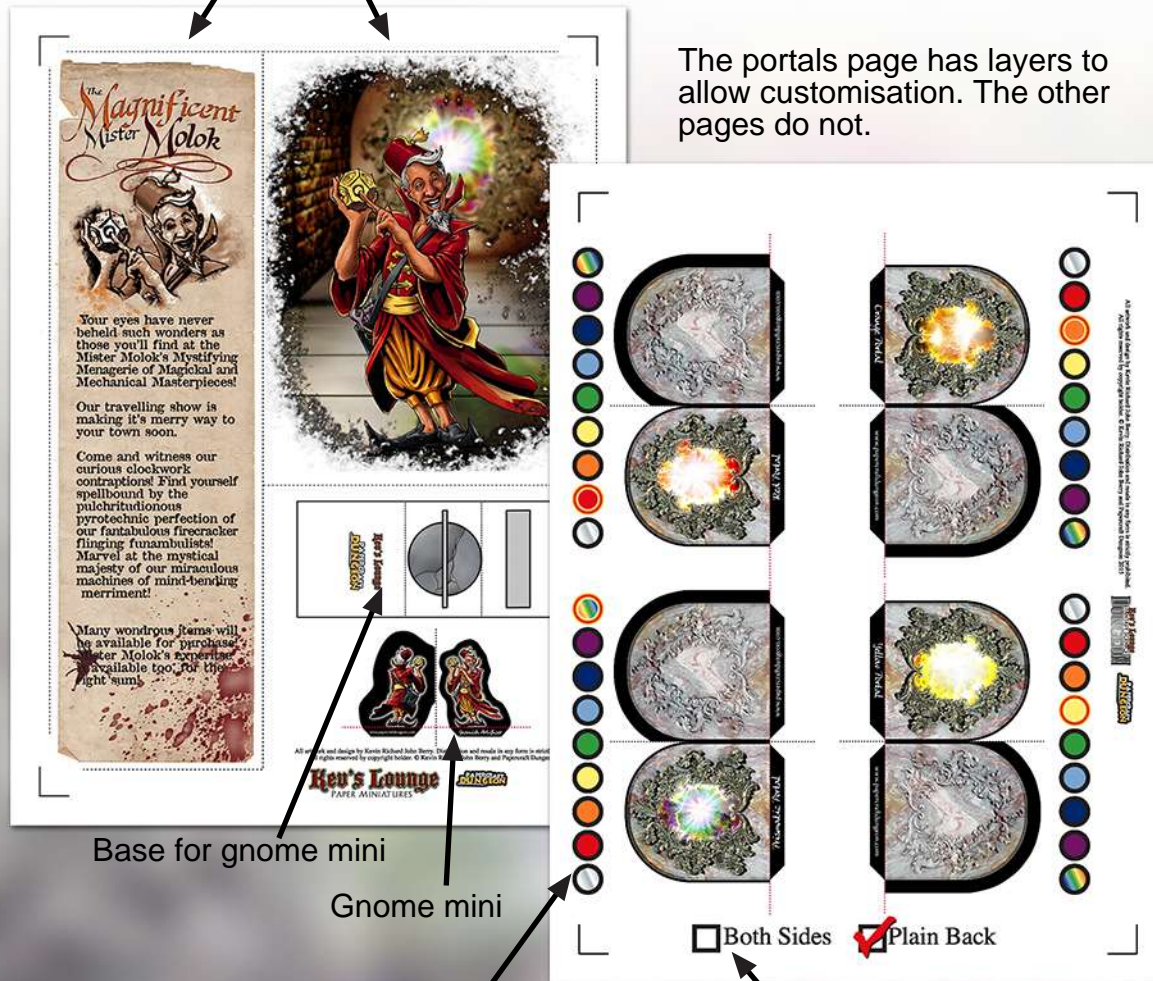

The portals page has layers to allow customisation. The other pages do not.

Base for gnome mini

Gnome mini

Click these buttons to change the colour of the accompanying mirror.

Click this button to make the portal double sided.

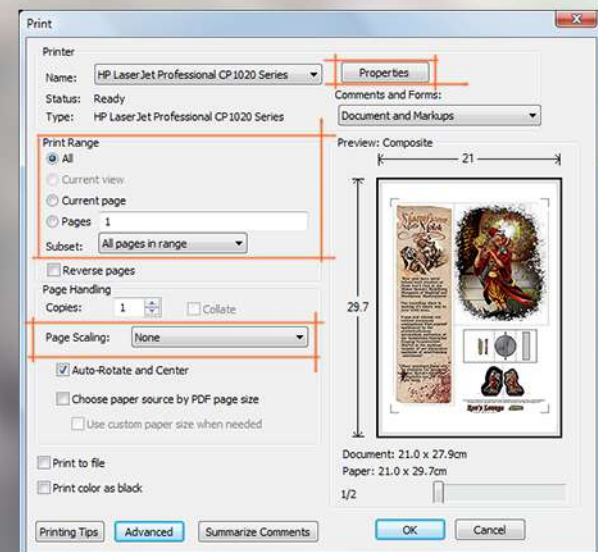
We recommend using 200gsm cardstock, or inkjet photo paper.

Navigate to File>Print, and ensure that the following options are set:

- Page Scaling is set to "None"

In the same Print Menu, click on properties and check the following options:

- Print Quality should be "Medium" or higher to get the best results from your prints.
- If using Inkjet Photo Paper, select that as Paper Type. Otherwise, select Plain Paper for the best results.

Separate the components of the Gnome Artificer page. Cut out the player supplements and keep the separate for use in your game.

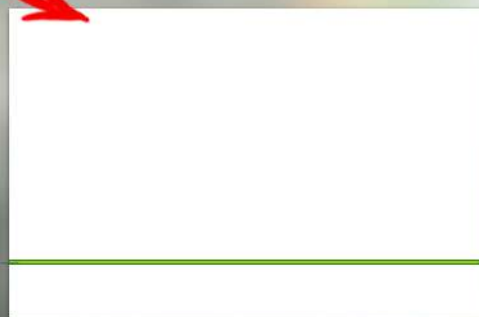

Start with the gnome mini. Slit the page on the tips of the red dotted lines as shown in orange below.



Flip it over and score using the slits as a guide, as shown below in green.

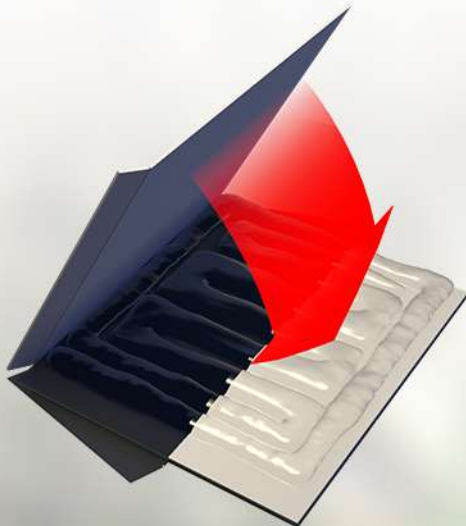
Flip the page over again and score along the dotted line down the centre as indicated in green below.



Slit the tabs, as shown above in orange.

Fold over the sheet along the score lines and glue the fronts and backs together as shown.



Be sure to keep the stand tabs free of glue when doing this!

Carefully trim the white away using a sharp craft knife. Cutting as shown by the orange lines following the direction of the arrows is the easiest way to do this cleanly.



There's a pretty thick border so you don't need to be quite this precise if you don't want to!

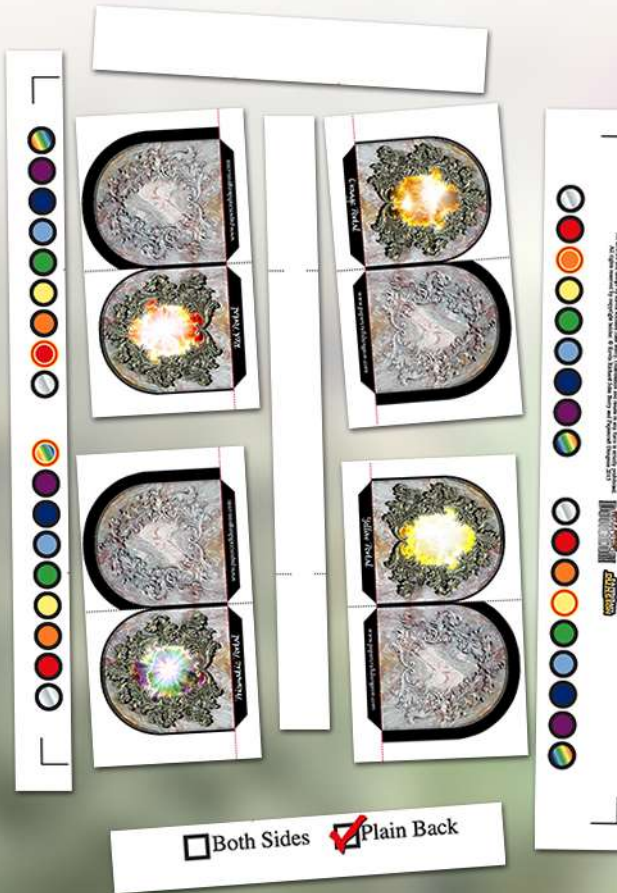

For the best results, you should blacken the white edges with a black felt tip marker.

Separate the portals to make them easier to work with.

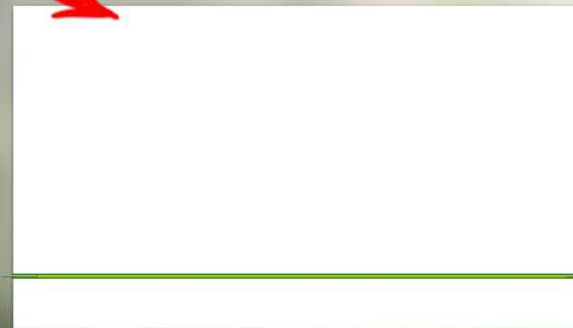

Slit the page on the tips of the red dotted lines as shown in orange below.



Flip it over and score using the slits as a guide, as shown below in green.

Flip the page over again and score along the dotted line down the centre as indicated in green below.

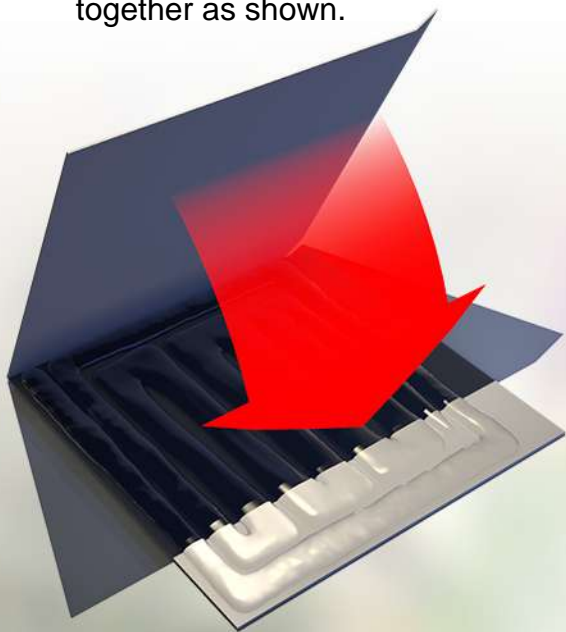


Slit the tabs, as shown below in orange.

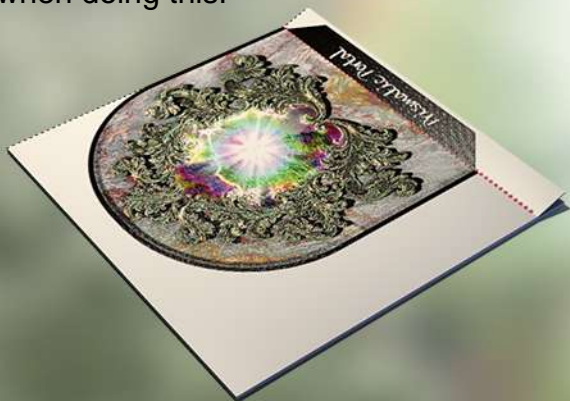

Fold over the sheet along the score lines and glue the fronts and backs together as shown.

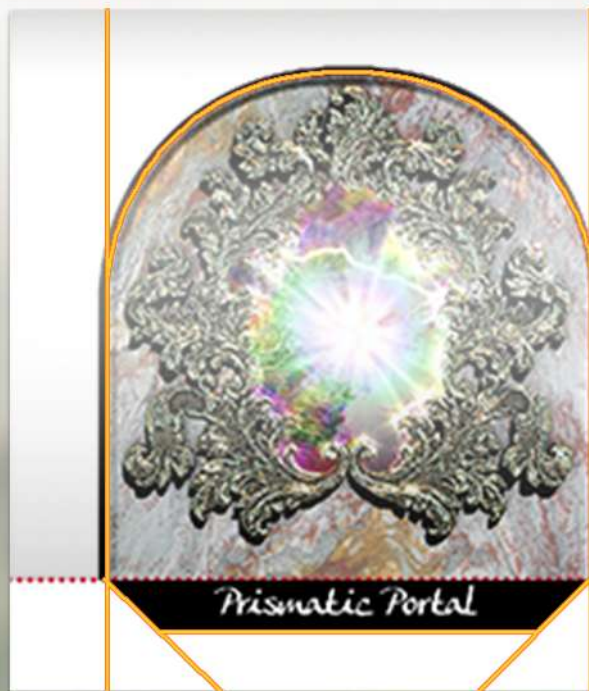


Be sure to keep the stand tabs free of glue when doing this!

Cut out the portal as shown below in orange. Use a sharp knife and steel ruler for the straight edges. You may find cutting the curved top easier with a pair of scissors.

For the best results, you should ink the white edges with an appropriately coloured felt tip marker.

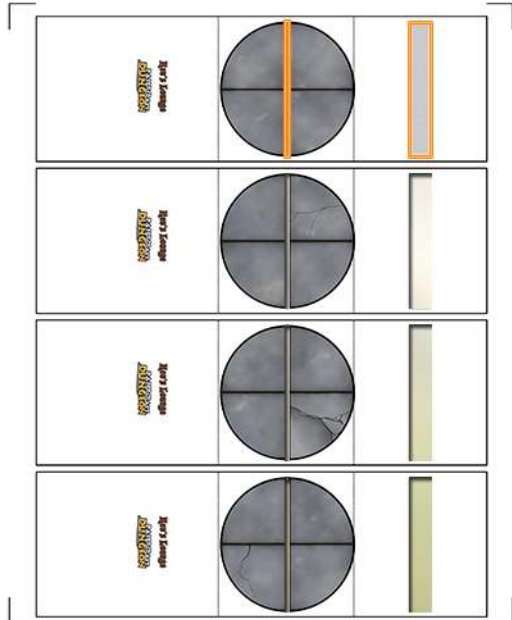


Alternatively, use a black marker.

Cut out the slots.

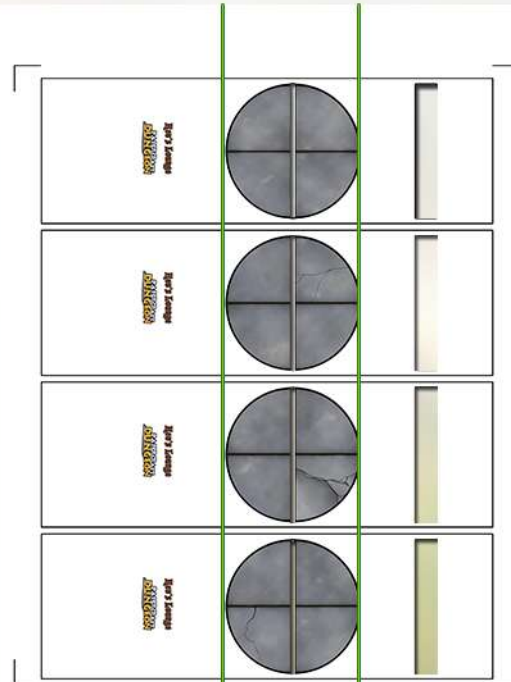

Score along the dotted lines as shown below in green.



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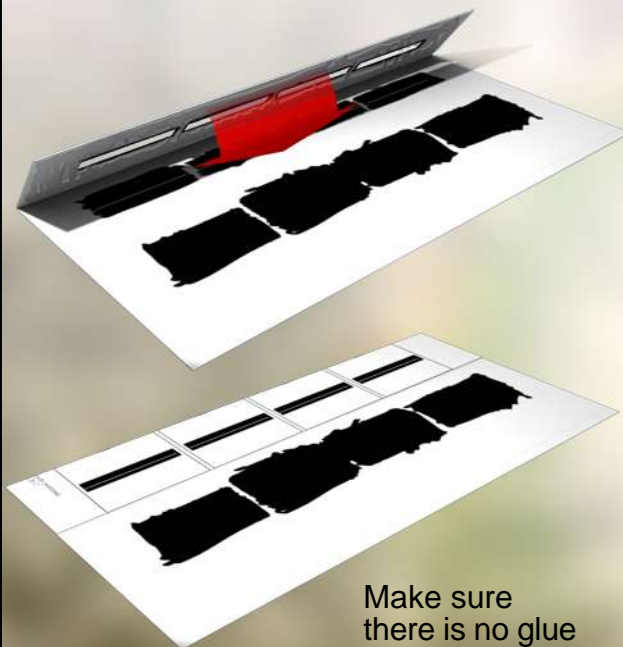

Flip the page over and lay down some black patches with a felt tip marker. Also cover in the inner edges of each slot.

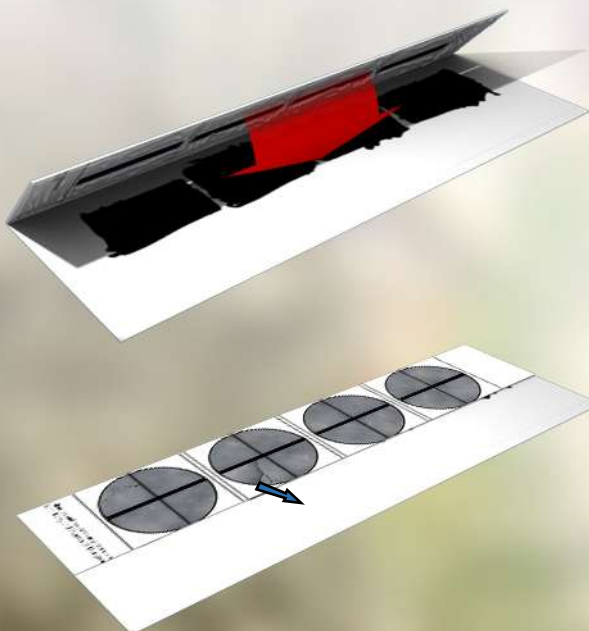
Fold over and glue down the inner flap as shown



Make sure there is no glue in the windows.

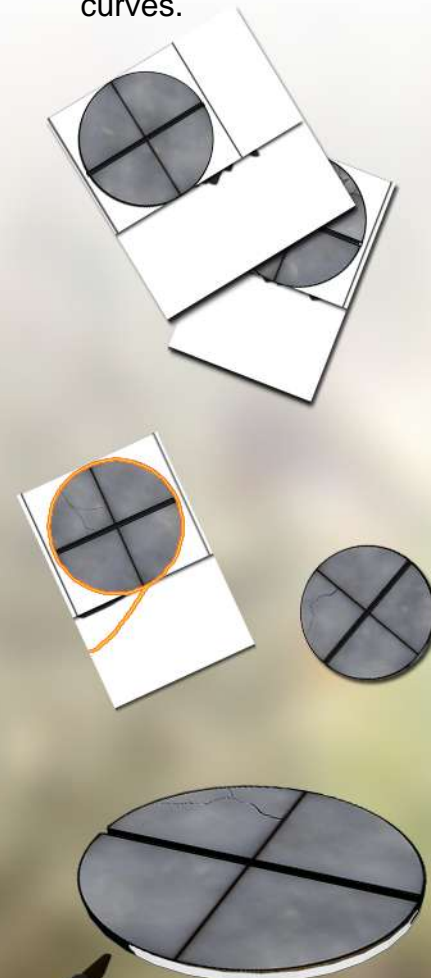

Fold the flap over again gluing it in place. Again, ensure that there is no glue in the windows.

Separate the bases and trim them down to size. A sharp pair of scissors is the best way to get perfect smooth round curves.



Cover the white edges with a black felt tip marker

Slide the figures into the bases and you're ready to use them!



When you're packing them away you can separate the figures from the bases allowing you to store them very compactly!
